

Message from the Board (con't) By Chris Feduniw

Any member is welcome to request a copy of the financial statements from the Club Treasurer if you would like further details and attend the monthly board meeting.

The event costs are where we've had to make the biggest adjustment for 2013. The Board looked at the profit and loss for events for the last two years and found the vast majority of the events were losing money resulting in a negative cash flow at the end of each year. In other words, between membership and event fees each year, we were spending more money than we were taking in and eating into the Club reserve fund.

When we looked at what it cost the Club to pay for launch fees, boat and tow vehicle gas, the average cost per boat per day is coming in around \$140-\$180. We can blame this on the ever- increasing cost of gas, higher launch fees, and newer boats that can only run on premium gas (91+ Octane). As such, the Board is recommending that all event chairs use \$50 per member as the starting point for a day event and then adjust the cost up or down depending on the location of the event and how far each boat owner needs to travel to the event. We assumed 4-5 people per boat with the boat owner, their co-member/co-captain, and the event chair & co-chair who attend for free to determine the \$50 cost per member. **Note:** *Camping & houseboat events boat owners, co-captain, and event chairs/co-chairs may have to pay for partial event fees.*

In addition to past event cost history, former president, Mark Capalongan created a spreadsheet that estimates the event cost based on average gas consumption of a boat to pull skiers/boarders from one marina to another and average tow vehicle cost per mile. Members can check out the spreadsheet by logging into the Club website and clicking on 'Members only' content and then 'Club Documents' and then downloading spreadsheet. As a boat owner myself I can tell you that I typically burn 25-30+ gallons per day with 4-5 people each skiing 4-5 runs which totals to about \$4.85 - \$5.25/gal at the Marina gas stations. People are usually surprised the first time they go out how much gas a boat burns. My response is think about what would happen if you took a full size 8 cylinder cars put it into first gear and then floored it, driving for 10-15 min and never changing gears, stopped and then did that again and again for 4-6 hours a day. My bet is at the end of the day, your car would have used just as much if not more gas which is pretty much what these boat engines are doing during the day of skiing/boarding.

Of course for non-members, we will continue to charge a premium and continue to have member-only events as we do want membership to have privileges. The Board will also continue to monitor the profit and loss of each event and the cost of gas, adjusting the event cost up or down appropriately as the goal for any event is to break even.

The Board realizes that \$50 for a day event where you typically get 2 runs in the morning and 2 runs in the afternoon is fairly expensive and the weather can be unpredictable. We still hope everyone can attend as many events as possible. Remember: this is not only an opportunity to get out on the water but it's also a chance to hook-up with other boat owners and get to know them so you can coordinate your schedules to get out on the water apart from club events. Boat owners are more likely to invite you to come out on their boat if they know you will be a good and fun crew member!

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Speaking of getting out on the water outside of the first-time Club events, members can also post and subscribe to the <u>members-only forum</u> on the Club website where we have forums for 'Boat Owners,' 'Looking for a Crews' and 'Riders looking for a Pull' as well as other members-only forums.

I frequently use the Club Forum to post entries when I'm looking for crews to get out on the water during weeknights and weekends of non-club events.



<u>Step 1.</u> Create or reset your password:

A) Go to the new website <u>www.bawsc.org</u> & click on the "Forgot Password" link in the upper right hand corner of the home page and enter your e-mail address in the "e-mail (user-id)" field and then the six digit anti-spam characters into the "code" field and finally click on the "Submit" button which will then send an e-mail to that address with a link to create or reset your password.

B) Open the e-mail and click on the e-mail link and enter & confirm your chosen password then click "**Submit**".

(Note: The first time you actually log into the new site you will be asked by Wild Apricot to accept their use policy.)

<u>Step 2.</u> Initiate your new-member on-line application:

Note: BAWSC offers members the option to include one significant other as a co-member under one membership fee called a "Membership Bundle*". Dependents under 12 years of age can also be added to your membership at no additional cost. Dependents aged 12-18 can be added to your membership for a small additional fee each year. Children over 18 and not living at home will have their own unique membership.

A) Click on the "**Become A BAWSC Member** (New <u>member application</u> Only)" link found in the left hand navigation bar on the web site home page <u>www.bawsc.org</u>.

B) Fill-out the requested information for yourself

Note: If you will be adding a co-member/membership bundle to your account you will do this after you initiate the membership application and your account has been activated.*

C) Make sure you click on the "<u>I ACCEPT I HAVE READ THE WAIVER AND RELEASE</u>" link to read the club waiver and then click on the check box to accept.

D) If you will be adding dependents to your account beyond a single co-member, you will enter them in the "Additional Information" area of the Membership form. For each dependent you have between 12 to 18 please check the box for each person. If you have any dependents under 12 you want to associate with your membership enter the total number of children under 12 in the "Number of Children Under 12" field.

E) If you are a **boat owner**, please enter in the information requested for your boat and **send proof of insurance** as requested on the form to the Membership Chair.

F) Enter what water-sports you and your dependents participate in.

G) Click "Next" to review your completed membership form and Total Membership Fees that will be owed.

H) If everything looks correct, click on the "**Confirm and Proceed with Payment**" button to initiate your registration. *This step will automatically send a confirmation e-mail titled* "*Membership initiated at Bay Area Water Ski Club*" to you.

I) Check your e-mail for that confirmation that your account has been successfully initiated and an invoice with instructions how to submit your membership dues payment.

<u>Step 3.</u> Send your membership dues to the Membership Chair (*payable to BAWSC*):

Step 4. Complete your membership application/setup (ONLY after receipt of dues payment):

Once your membership dues have been received, you will get an e-mail confirmation from the BAWSC Membership Chair verifying your account is active, at which time you can then complete your membership application & setup by choosing your **privacy** and **e-mail subscriptions** an well as set-up yourself as a Bundle Administrator to **add a co-member** to your account bundle.

A) Log onto the web site with your e-mail (user-id) and password. www.bawsc.org

B) Click "View Profile" in the upper right hand corner of the home page.

C) Click "Edit profile"

D) Review and modify your **privacy settings**, click "**Privacy**" and edit any field you don't want visible to other BAWSC members and then click "**Save**".

E) **Insure you are subscribed** to receive e-mail notifications from the *forum based message boards* when someone posts they are looking for a pull, crew, etc.

a) Click on "<u>Members Only Content</u>" link found on the left hand navigation bar and then "<u>Member</u> <u>Forums</u>" (and "Board Forums" if you are board member) and click on each forum you want to receive e-mail and then click on the "**Subscribe to Forum**" link. **BAWSC On-line Membership Application (con't)**

b) Then go back and click on "**View Profile**" again, click "**Edit profile**" and click "**e-mail subscriptions**" and then adjust how you want to receive e-mails; immediately, daily or weekly when someone posts to the forum. The default is daily. Then click "**Save**".

F) Setup a Co-Member Bundle*

Each paid member is allowed to add a significant other to their account as a "Bundled" co-member. The following steps can be performed to add another person to your account once your membership fee has been received and your account has been activated by the Membership Chair.

- a) Log into the web site with your e-mail (user-id) and password. www.bawsc.org
- b) Click on the "View Profile" button found in the upper right hand corner of the home page.
- c) In the "My profile" screen scroll down to the "Bundle summary" section and then click " Add member"

d) You will then be presented with the membership application page where you will then fill out the form on behalf of your co-member.

e) Click "SAVE" and the co-member will be added to your account and they will receive their user-id (their e-mail address) and password setup link at the e-mail address you entered on the form. You will become the "Bundle Administrator*" for your bundled co-member.

CONGRATULATIONS, YOU HAVE COMPLETED YOUR BAWSC MEMBERSHIP APPLICA-TION AND SETUP. We look forward to you joining us at BAWSC Events.

Note: If you receive an error message when clicking "SAVE" that states "This e-mail is already in use" you will then need to contact the BAWSC Membership Chair listed on the <u>Contacts</u> Page to manually associate that e-mail address with your account as Wild Apricot currently does not allow a member to add an existing Contact or Member to their bundle themselves. A member can only add a new Contact or new Member to their account themselves.

*The way Wild Apricot handles multiple people under one membership is called a <u>Membership Bundle</u>. A membership bundle is a group of members who are linked together and managed by one of their members – the bundle administrator. Bundle members share the same renewal date, status, and membership level.
